Certificate II in Construction – Plumbing

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Training School: Banksia Park International High School
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Course Description

You will undertake competency based training on and off the job in: OHSW, White Card, Manual Handling, First Aid, leveling, trench calculations, drain cleaning, copper tube work and general construction. This program provides the opportunity for participants to experience, first hand; work in the plumbing and construction industry while at school and to gain Certificate II in Construction. It provides participants with industry-accepted skills that may benefit them in the transition from school to work.

Structured Work Placement

Students undertake work placement in industry off site. They are assessed on-the-job and this forms part of the student's Vocational Education and Training assessment requirements in completing the competencies required for the certificate. 20 days of work placement is required.
